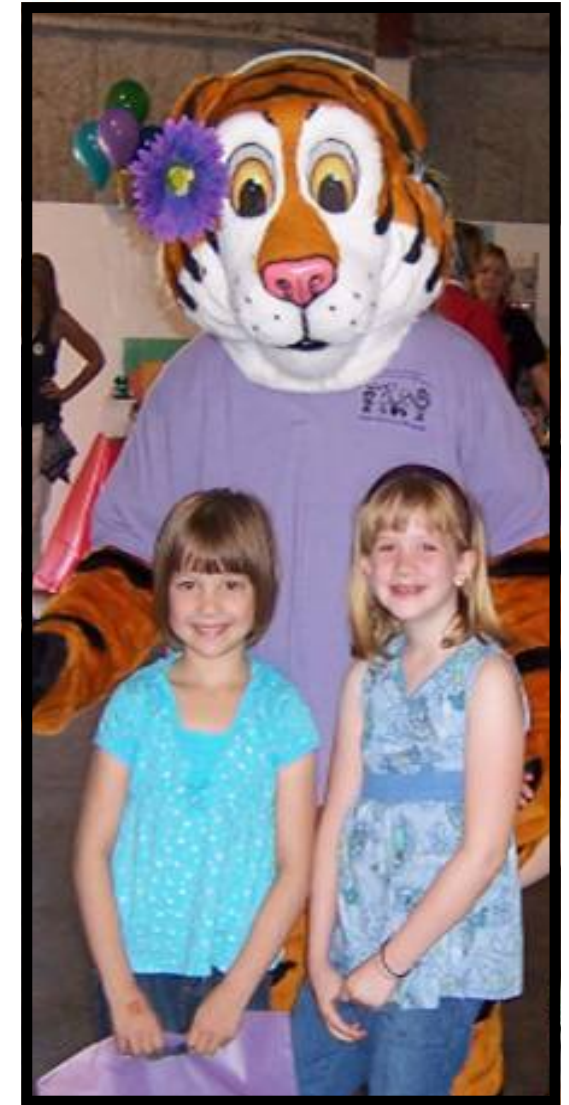

The **Children's Fair of Tehama County** brings together families and local organizations that provide services for young children, in celebration of community, childhood, and the spirit of learning. Held the fourth Saturday in April, the Children's Fair is open from 10 a.m. until 3 p.m. at the Tehama District Fairgrounds in Red Bluff.

The Children's Fair offers an informative day of creating, exploring, and fun at booths sponsored by local organizations, including preschools, extra-curricular activity providers (such as scouts, martial arts, music and art), child safety organizations, fire and police departments, local recreation areas, and a number of churches. Northern California Productions provides music and entertainment throughout the day.

Activities include face painting, pony rides, an obstacle course, crafts, bean bag toss, and much more. There are always a number of vehicles on display, including fire and rescue trucks, a school bus, Tehama Rural Express bus, and the First Five California Hands-On Health van. Books for children are given away by the Tehama County Reading Council in partnership with the Beta Lambda Chapter of Delta Kappa Gamma. Costumed characters appearing at the

Children's Fair have included Cookie Monster, Tabby Tiger, the Tooth Fairy, and McGruff the Crime Dog.

Explorer Post 120, from the Tehama County Sheriff's Department, helps out with traffic concerns, while Red Bluff High School students earn community service hours by assisting in booth set-up and decorating. The Red Bluff Kiwanis Club provides popcorn and drinks to all children attending the Children's Fair. The Job Training Center and Tehama District Fairground crews help set up the tables and dividers for nearly 50 inside booths, while many booths are set up outside on the grassy area, weather permitting.

Everything is free to the families attending thanks to participating organizations and generous local sponsorship, as well as volunteer efforts of dozens of community members.
